## FAI SPORTING LICENSE

Each competitor and team manager must possess a FAI Sporting License valid for the year of the Championship. This license must be registered in the FAI licenses database.

## COMPETITION RULE

According to the valid FAI Sporting Code, as well as all applicable amendments.

## OFFICIAL LANGUAGES

Official languages are English and Mongolian.

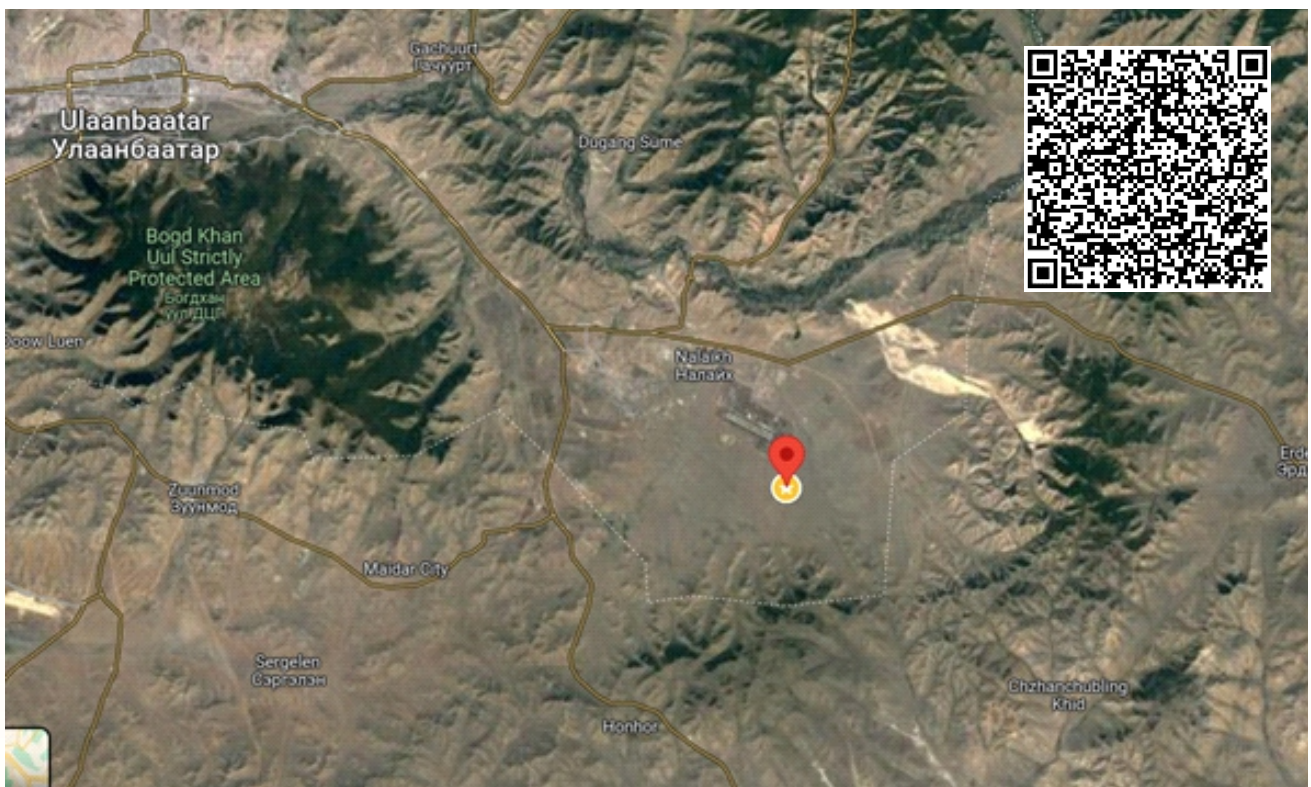
## COMPOSITION OF NATIONAL TEAM

Hold in each class of F1A, F1B, F1C and F1Q. Each National Federation/National Aeroclub may enter a team consisting of 3 competitors or 4 competitors if at least one is female and a team manager. The team manager may have an assistant. The team flies from one pole.

ATTENTION! While the Competitions, entrance into the Start Line area is allowed ONLY to those persons, who passed the official registration (FAI Jury, Competitors, Team Managers, Coaches, Helpers, Supporter, Timekeepers, Event Organizers) and have the registration badge. Moreover, all other persons and visitors should be out of approximately 25-30 m zone.

## FLYING SITE LOCATION

Flying site – the field of “Darkhan Noyonii Khudag” approximately 50 km to the east from city of Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. There is an area of at least 7km by 5km of short smooth grass. You can see the flying field on internet by Google-earth software with the pointer 47°43'59.90” N, 107°23'34.17” E.



## TIMEKEEPERS

Organizers will provide local timekeepers. Each participating country may enter a timekeeper and these timekeepers will be preferably used. The intention to enter a timekeepers should be announced in Entry Form. All these timekeepers should speak basic technical English.

The priority as for selecting timekeepers will be as follows:

- Competitors in F1A, F1B, F1C, F1Q;
- Competitors in other classes;
- Everyone, who wants to be a timekeeper and has an experience.

Timekeepers will be provided with binoculars, stop-watches, chairs and umbrellas.

## AWARDS AND PRIZES

FAI medals and diplomas as well as FAI trophies will be awarded to the first three in individual and team classification including a team manager. Organizer will award trophies to the best three individuals and teams as well as countries.

Females are considered for the following awards:

- FAI medals and diplomas will be awarded to the first, second and third placed females only if six (6) or more females are competing. If the number of females' participants is less than this number (six), then only FAI diplomas will be awarded;
- The best female earns the title of Female Continental Champion if females from at least four different nations participate in that class and the total number of females are six (6) or more.

## ANTI-DOPING

If a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List for a medical condition, then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

## PROTEST FEE

The protest fee is 50 EUR.

## ENTRY FEE

- Team manager and assistant team manager – 270 EUR;  
    Senior competitor – 270 EUR;  
    Helper or Supporter – 30 EUR;

NOTE: These fees for team managers and competitors include the 10 CHF which the organizer must pay to the FAI.

## BANQUET

- Adult – 50 EUR
- Junior – 25 EUR

The form consists only the name of the country, number of competitors, team managers, and helpers. If you are still in doubts as for the precise names of your team, just write the total number of persons.

## DEADLINES

- Deadline for reception of the Preliminary Entry Form is March 01, 2024;
- Deadline for reception of the Final Entry Form is April 01, 2024;
- Entry fees must be paid no later than May 01.

Entry fees not paid at this deadline may incur a 10% penalty. Entry fees payment of entry fees at the arrival on the site will not be accepted.

## DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

- Competitor's FAI License valid for 2024;
- A copy of team's banking payment receipt or cash receipt on registration site;
- One national flag approximately 120×150 cm;
- One CD or MP3 format with their national anthem;
- Valid FAI certificates for the models.

All models must be processed by their NAC, with FAI certificates and stickers in accordance with CIAM General rules C.12. Model aircraft not properly processed by their NAC with FAI certificates and stickers, will be processed by the organizer at a cost 8 Euro for each model.

## FOOD, FACILITIES AND SERVICES ON THE FLYING SITE

- Lunch package and water during the competition day included in entry fee;
- Refreshments, drinks and food will be available at the flying field during the competition and training days.

## ACCOMMODATION

Camp hotels are available approximately 5-30 km distances from the competition flying field. Hotel information and online booking can be found on the web site (<https://ihotel.mn>).



## INSURANCE

The Organizer will provide third party insurance cover to all participants for accidents involving injury to others or damage to property according to the host country's legislation. All the participants must have their own health insurance to cover illness and accidents.

## MEDICAL TEAM

During the Championships, a doctor and an emergency will be present at the flying field.
